

One thing is for sure!: the certainty of change.

There are very few things which are unchanging. Death and taxes are apparently all we can rely on!

That, and the changeability of change itself. It feels like there is very little for us to hold on to. The world appears to be quite different from the one we knew in the past and the rate of change is escalating at an unbelievable rate. There is a saying something about the fact that we are trying now to educate children to do jobs which are not in existence yet.

It is tempting in the face of such rapid change to just hold on tight to everything we have, to just shut down and close the shutters. This is happening all over the world in a political sense as people find themselves fearful of all that they do not know or understand. It is very tempting from a church perspective to do exactly that. How vastly different does church look now to how it did 40 years ago as the three traditions became the Uniting Church, the first truly Australian church? How proud I am of those who walked this unknown path and bravely risked what they had known in the past for what they could become in the future. What courage! They did this in order to leave the church in a good place for those of us coming after. I pray God that we are committed to this same end. God grant us the courage to seek the vision of a renewed church for our children.

We are faced with these same choices and really the grief and anguish associated with such huge change makes it feel as though it isn't worth it. But we know that this is after all the nature of faith. To step into the unknown having prayed and discerned the way forward. This is what those in the time of Uniting did, and it is also what our Partnership has done. We have seen God at work in and through people who have been prepared to be vulnerable. We have taken the risk and pulled up sleeves. Instead of bemoaning what appears to be church decline we have recognised that the church is not ours. It belongs to Jesus, and the Spirit of God continues to move through our churches and in reaching outward. The Spirit calls us into our communities to minister to others, especially the poor and marginalised.

How encouraging it is to see others decide that, rather than hide away in their fear, they will write a new story, a new narrative of peace and hope and grace in what surely is a deeply hurting world. So let us hold onto those verses in Scripture which call us not to be afraid. Despite our grief at our perceived loss, let us continue as good and faithful servants of the church. Let us draw together to "midwife" the birth of new and refreshing incarnations and expressions of church.

Seems that there is really quite a lot we can rely on, and God is faithful and steadfast in every,

moment, every situation.

And so in the words of the modern 'prophet' Michael Leunig......

God help us to change. To change ourselves and to change our world. To know the need for it. To deal with the pain of it. To feel the joy of it. To undertake the journey without understanding the destination. The art of gentle revolution.


#### WHY DOES IT SUCCEED?


