### Being there, on the edge...



As I write this, there are numerous reports of flooding across the state. Some minor and others quite significant. Charlton reports a 1 in 10-year flood event and Casterton and Coleraine have had

evacuations. Ironically it won't be long and we will be back into the fire season and I remember it is just under 12 months ago we had an unseasonal hot spell that resulted in major fires affecting many in our communities in the Partnership.

Disasters hit and people are hurt and suffer. At such times we try to find ways to pull together to support and aid those affected. Volunteer organisations such as the CFA, SES, Red Cross and VCC Emergency Services' Chaplaincy are at the forefront of efforts.

Around the Partnership in the coming month or so there will be services of blessing for our volunteer emergency services such as the CFA and the SES. It is a reminder to us that we are all part of a community that needs the contribution of each person. We all have a part to play. Some are able to fight fires, others provide relief and others backing and resourcing. We belong together and need each other.

As a Partnership we also come together to support each other in our struggles and needs. We work alongside each other to enable each one's ministry. In the midst of difficulties and uncertainties, there is a call to be life builders, healers and those who set free the wounded and downcast.

In the past there has been an expectation that when help was needed that those needing it would come to us. This may have been appropriate when the church was in the centre of the community. This paradigm no longer is helpful or works. We are called instead to recapture the calling of the early church to initiate the sharing of grace, to be in mission beyond our own safe space and to share good news in the spaces where people are.

The good news we have among us is that in the midst of all the ups and downs of life, God comes to us. God initiates the giving and sharing of grace and love. God invites us to share in this mission to reach beyond ourselves to share in the needs and support of those around us. As followers of Jesus we are then people who are called to be out there and on the edge – where ever there is need.

Over the coming weeks and months then, can I encourage you to look for opportunities to be where the need is? Even if you cannot be a fire-fighter or SES volunteer, find a way to support those who are. That may include attending the blessing services, praying for those participating, listening for a need that may be expressed and helping to find a way to meet it, donate to one of the agencies, help a neighbour prepare for the fire season or a myriad of other ways to engage and show God's love for all. As a Partnership, seeking to be a fresh expression of God's love and presence, let us be attuned to the ways God's Spirit can work in and through us.

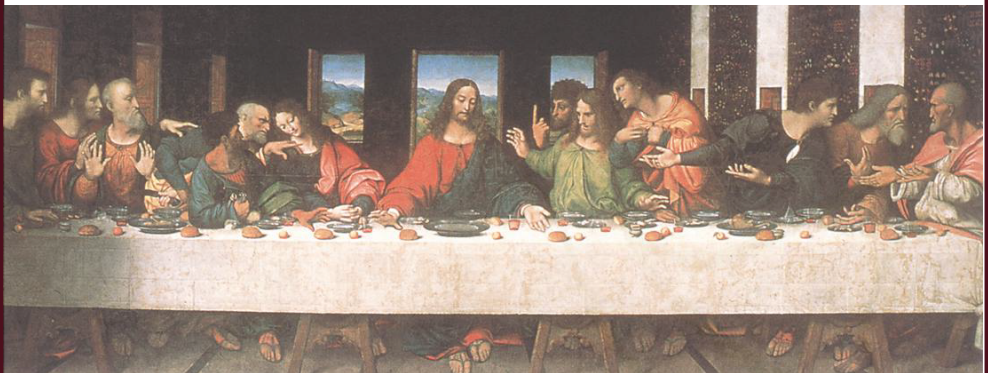

## COCO REPORT FOR MEETING HELD SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 10th 2016 AT WOODEND UC

Chairperson Colin welcomed us.

Robert Renton read us a poem by Bruce Prewer – explaining that things of which we are custodians don't belong just to us, Colin welcomed Peter Cannon back to the Partnership and CoCo – good to have him back and the Ministry Team in place. Robert Renton conducted an Affirmation of Annette's Induction with Wendy and Peter, as Peter wasn't at her Induction.

Correspondence: CoCo had asked for a Presbytery Rep. to attend CoCo meetings as Robert Renton who has been attending our meetings is retiring. Presbytery decided to have quarterly discussions with the Executive to keep up to date. Perhaps contact Presbytery by email or phone if we need advice. Comment made it won't be as 'hands on' as having Robert with us. Probably a need for a Representative from Kyneton and the Northern Congregations on the Executive and also the Ministry Team to keep everyone involved.

Finance: Treasurer Paul estimates after 4 years we may not have any money in reserve for on-going manse maintenance. We need to keep this in mind. We are OK in the short term. Supply Ministers are expensive, particularly travelling expenses – may have to re-evaluate services. Work out priorities.

The funding for Bronwyn in the Church Office has finished – need for volunteers in the Church Office. This will be brought to our attention as to what is required.

Manses: Romsey: Outside painting to be completed when weather permits. Phone is in. Internet available as of 12/9/2016. Heating sorted out.

Woodend: Spouting and downpipes need checking as water has been coming into the dining room.

Kyneton: Sale gone through – money is put aside for replacement manse if needed.

Need for Property Committee now Manses are occupied by the Ministers. George Roberts, Noel Shaw, David Liebich and Pip Elston to monitor maintenance of these assets. Will get guidelines in place for this task. They can co-opt assistance.

Church Office at Riddells Creek – has phone connected. The Office and the Church space are resources we need to use. Peter will be there for some time each day. He will have worship resources etc available for us to access.

Ministers' Reports: None due – only quarterly. Dates for Wendy's leave mentioned – email to be sent. The Memorandum of Understanding Review mentioned – Rose Broadstock coming later in the Meeting re this.

Joint Service on October 30th for Darcy Woods' 50 years in the Ministry being worked out. Darcy has organised Rev. Bruce Barber to preach. Ministers to liaise with Darcy to format Service. Catering aspect to be advised.

Social Justice: Northern Suburbs Asylum Seekers Meeting will be held soon. Romsey and Lancefield Catholic Priest organising a Picnic at Hanging Rock in the New Year for Asylum Seekers. Synod are running a family camp in Woodend in October. Wendy will keep Congregations informed as details become available.

Safe Church: Some discussion when the next Training Day will be held and where. Will find out what is available for our Reps to attend.

Presbytery stress Child Safe information needs to be understood. Communications from Presbytery need to be promoted and acted on straight away – don't wait for Church Council Meetings.

New Business: Gisborne Parish of the Anglican Church are running an Introduction to Ministry Course. See one of the Ministry Team if interested.

David Liebich reported on the future of the Riddells Creek Church – no motivation at this stage to continue as a Faith Community. Suggested a Meeting be held for the Riddell people to decide one way or the other. This must be resolved and Presbytery notified. We have to be careful of the property aspect, it could be taken over by Synod.

Wendy asked us to be mindful of Church Registers – Weddings, Funerals, Baptisms etc.

Rose Broadstock from Presbytery then took over to facilitate discussion about a Review of the Partnership and the Memorandum of Understanding. A Survey will be devised asking everyone questions about how the Partnership is working under CoCo's direction. A number of questions were suggested. The Executive, with Rose Broadstock on board, will pull the suggestions offered together. The Survey to be completed during four weeks from mid-October till mid-November.

Other Business: Neil Tweddle mentioned Rev. Paul Blacker had mentioned at Presbytery that a Cultural Audit of Port Phillip West was being held. A series of Workshops will be available at Geelong, Melton and other locations. We need to be aware of these and willing to participate when info becomes available.

House of The Rock Prayer Group (in Gisborne) are promoting shared groups to pray for concerns throughout the Macedon Ranges. The aim is to support each others' needs.

Reports from the Churches: Overall these Reports were positive. Good things happening throughout the Partnership. See the Partnership In Print for news of what is happening around the Churches.
